

PROJECT GRADUATION 2012

Project Graduation is an all-night, drug- and alcohol-free graduation celebration (to be held at a surprise location!) to which graduates will be bussed immediately following their graduation ceremony on Wednesday, May 23, 2012. This event has been held every year since 1990 and we usually have a 90-95% attendance of the senior class! The Project Graduation committee works hard all year long to make this event a fun, exciting, memorable event for all graduates.

Activities may include pool tables, bowling, food, video games, DJ, boxer bingo, casino and casino raffle, senior raffle, bus give-aways, massage chairs, magician, hypnotist, henna tattoos artists, manicures/pedicures, caricature artists, senior gift distribution, live entertainment and so much more!

This event costs approximately \$40,000 and we expect the 2012 class to have about 375 students. Senior parents are encouraged to make at least a \$100 suggested donation at the beginning of their child's senior year. Underclassmen parents are asked to begin making donations during their child's freshman year of \$25 so that by the time their child is a senior they will have paid in full the suggested \$100 to cover the cost of their child attending. All money raised is spent on the students!

There is a checkbox on the PTO registration form where you can earmark your donation to Project Graduation. You may make payments anytime during registration week at the PTO table, as well as all year long.

We do hold fundraisers throughout the year to help defray our costs; however, it is so helpful to have as much money as possible up front so our committee can focus more time and energy on planning the event, rather than funding it!!

All seniors are invited to attend, whether or not they can afford all, none or part of the suggested \$100 donation!
